| Waiver | <p>Participating in the race implies an implicit acceptance of the associated rules in full. Each rider understands and admits that his/her participation in the event is voluntary. He/She assumes full responsibility for any injuries or damages from his/her participation in, or practice for, the event.</p> <p>He/She recognizes and understands that mountain biking and the activities associated with this event may be dangerous, that his/her participation is solely at his/her own risk and that he/she assumes full responsibility for any resulting injuries and damages that may occur.</p> <p>He/She acknowledges that riding during this race will be of a high technical standard and many of the trails require riding at high speed.</p> <p>Every rider affirms that he/she is in good health. He/She declares that he/she is physically fit and capable to participate in the event. Every rider understands it can be a strenuous day.</p> <p>Every rider must acknowledge that he/she has read and understood this entire waiver of liability and agrees to be legally bound by it.</p> <p>The organization maintains a civil liability insurance on race days. But it is highly recommended that each rider has their own race insurance in order to cover any eventuality.</p> |

Mandatory Protection gear

CE approved full-face helmet, knee pads and gloves mandatory for race stages (during training and on race days). Back protector (or backpack with back protector), elbow pads, goggles/glasses recommended. Open face helmet may be worn during the liaisons only.

Penalties

Riders will have pre-assign times, arriving late the penalty will be your own late time+stage actual time.

Arriving early at the start line- 2min

Misconduct in any kind -DSQ

Receiving external help outside the official zone- DSQ

Practice done illegally and/or not respecting the practice rules-10min

tech support

External support (medical, mechanic, other) is only allowed on the designated area on the map course.

Feed Zones

On the course map will be signed the food zones. The food zones will carry water, isotonic drinks and diverse solid foods.

WC

There's a public bathroom near the parking lot on the village. Check course map

Medical Assistance

An ambulance and a Rescue team (doctor, nurse+rappel technicians) will be in strategic points of the race

**Health center/
Hospital**

The nearest health center is in Vila do Nordeste at 300m from the start/finish line, Hospital in Ponta Delgada at 59km (47min +/-)
